Youth, young adults, and adult leaders may participate at CI. Come be a part of this experience, listen to encouraging speakers, reflect on God's word, and join the many activities like small groups, praise and worship, team competitions, talent night, and much, much, much more!

If you are in **7th Grade to 2nd year Post-High**, you can attend CI as a *delegate*. CI is also looking for spiritually-grounded, faithful, responsible people **Post-High and beyond** to serve on our *leadership team*. Meetings for 2009 are already underway. As always, **ANYONE IS WELCOME** to come as a *visitor*. (You must check in/out with the CI-PNW Registrar and subject to minimal fees.)

All local churches must provide **1 adult chaperone** (age 23+) for every 6 youth delegates they send. Churches are asked to help subsidize registration fees for their participants by fundraising. **CI-PNW scholarships** are available, but *funding is limited. Partial scholarships may be awarded to individuals who apply early, demonstrate financial need, and have not been awarded many CI-PNW scholarships in the past.
